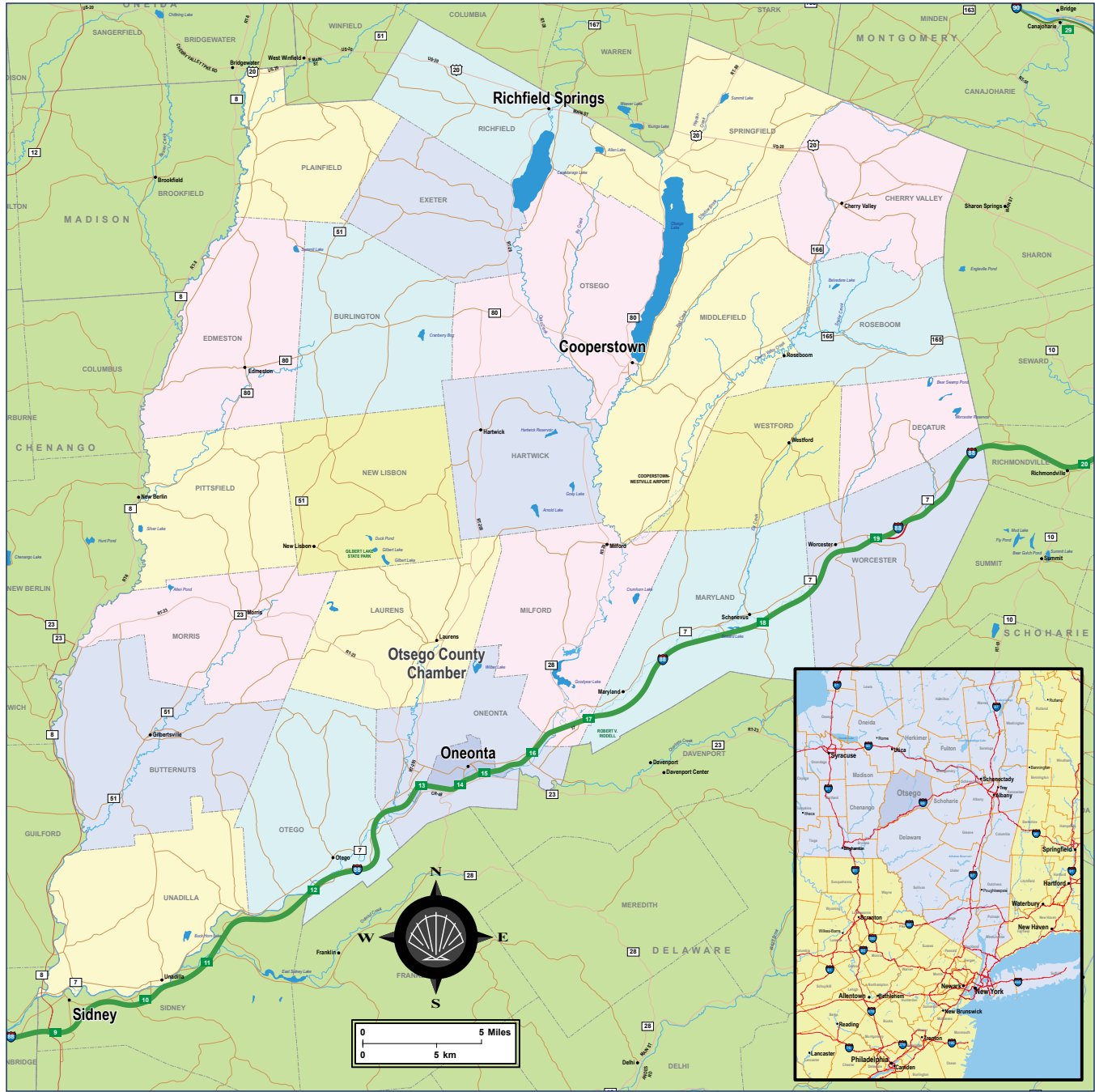
THIS IS OTSEGO COUNTY

This pleasant and historic village lies along the southern shore of Otsego Lake, which is the source of the north branch of the Susquehanna River, but, more importantly is home to the National Baseball Hall of Fame and Museum. Like Cooperstown, the rest of Otsego County is a land that nature has favored. The beauty of our natural surroundings provides for many outdoor activities of biking, hiking, kayaking, boating and fishing. From the summer Oneonta Outlaw baseball games, to Balloon Festival to the Cooperstown Winter Carnival, to local farmers markets each unique season brings something new to do in Otsego County.

Our diverse, vibrant arts, music and culture scene shows our community's drive to continuously embrace an authentic community. The area has become an education hub of world-class colleges, creating an atmosphere of enthusiasm, innovation, and economic prosperity. Otsego County has opportunities and stability, innovation and community. Community OVERVIEW

Otsego County is located in South Central New York, 60 miles northeast (via I-88) of Binghamton, 70 miles southwest (via I-88) of Albany, and 65 miles south of Utica. Oneonta, the only designated city in Otsego, is located along four exits of I-88. Cooperstown, the County Seat, is located just twenty miles north of Oneonta. The current population of Otsego County is stable at 61,000. Oneonta’s population is now at 14,000. The village of Cooperstown has a population of about 1,800.

TRANSPORTATION - Otsego County is served by two airports: **Oneonta Airport** (391 Airport Road, Box 721, Oneonta, NY 13820; 607-431-1076) and **Cooperstown-Westville Airport** (982 State Route 166, Cooperstown, NY 13326; 607-286-9013). Commercial air service is available in nearby Albany, Binghamton, Rome, and Syracuse.

Otsego Express, or “Gus the Bus,” is the county transit system which provides county-wide service on a fixed-route system. Oneonta Public Transit (OPT) operates between Cooperstown and Oneonta hourly in addition to providing bus service in and around Oneonta. The Village of Cooperstown operates a trolley to transport visitors from perimeter parking lots on Routes 80 and 28 to the National Baseball Hall of Fame and Museum and other points of interest.

MEDIA - In addition to the daily newspaper, *The Daily Star*, Otsego County has several weekly newspapers, including *The Freeman’s Journal*, *Hometown Oneonta*, and *The Cooperstown Crier*. Townsquare Media operates WZOZ



(103.1 FM), WKXZ (93.9 FM), WDOS (730 AM), and WSRK (103.9 FM) radio stations. Also serving most of Otsego County is WCDO (1490 AM / 100.9 FM) in Sidney.

GOVERNMENT - Otsego County is governed by the 14-member Otsego County Board of Representatives. A chairman is elected annually from their membership and serves as Otsego County’s Chief Elected Official. Through a series of standing committees, the board creates, develops, and enacts legislation.

Otsego County’s city, Oneonta, operates under the City Manager-Council form of government. The City Manager is the Chief Executive Officer and the Chief Administrative Officer. The Common Council is made up of eight Councilors, with one elected from each of the eight wards. The county’s 24 towns are governed by town boards, which consist of a supervisor and four council members. The ten county villages are governed by a Board of Trustees, which consists of the Mayor and two to six trustees.

ENERGY - Otsego County is generally served by New York State Electric and Gas (NYSEG) Corporation. NYSEG serves approximately 85–87% of Otsego County’s population. The Otsego Electric Cooperative serves the remainder of the county.

HISTORY – South Central New York was home to the Iroquois League of Nations who lived throughout southern New York and the Mohawk Valley from at least 1450 CE. Recent archaeological findings indicate the presence of native people as early as 4500 BCE in the area known today as Otsego County.

In 1740, settlers arrived in Cherry Valley in the northeast corner of Otsego County. The total population did not exceed 900 until the Revolutionary War brought an influx of settlers to South Central New York.

Otsego County was one of three counties split off from Montgomery, the other two being Herkimer and Tioga. Otsego County was officially established on February 16, 1791 and Cooperstown became its county seat. The original county consisted of three townships: Cherry Valley in the northeast, Otsego in the northwest, and Harpersfield in the south.

By 1830, the population reached 51,361. Between 1792 and 1849, the 24 towns that exist today were formed. During the Civil War period, the county's population reached nearly 60,000, where it has remained during the last century and a half.

In its early years, Otsego County was a national leader in the production of hops for breweries. Inexpensive water power encouraged the import of cotton to produce textiles at numerous mills. Until the 1880s, Otsego County remained agrarian and isolated.

When the railroad arrived, Otsego County began to change. Several railroads were constructed, including the Albany and Susquehanna, later called the Delaware and Hudson. This interurban line extended from Oneonta to the Mohawk Valley. The Ulster and Delaware Railroad brought freight and passengers to and from the Hudson Valley and Oneonta. After 1865, the railroad helped transform Oneonta into a growing and prosperous village.

Railroads eventually declined in importance. Passenger train service stopped in Oneonta in early 1963. The economic significance of the railroad was replaced by Oneonta's Hartwick College and the State University College at Oneonta, which created jobs and education opportunities.

AREA TOPOGRAPHY, WATER, SOIL AND WEATHER –

Located in the foothills of the northern and western fringe of the Catskill Mountains, Otsego County comprises just over 1,000 square miles. The county's hilly terrain includes numerous small mountains, all less than 1,000 feet in height.

The headwaters of the North Branch of the Susquehanna River flow south from Otsego Lake into the Catskill Mountains. Along with Otsego, there are three other lakes in the county: Canadarago, Gilbert, and Goodyear.

Winters are typically brisk and snowy. Spring progresses from chilly to warm days over just a few weeks. Anyone who has ever lived in or visited here will tell you that we have great summers, with many warm days and cool nights. Fall is a long and beautiful season, marked by spectacular foliage displays and steady, warm daytime temperatures.

Business & INDUSTRY

Otsego County is home to a diverse mix of industrial, manufacturing, and high-tech enterprises, existing side-by-side with retail, educational, and healthcare institutions. New businesses also continue to grow and prosper in Otsego County. The wide variety of products manufactured here includes communications equipment, integrated circuits, pharmaceuticals, transportation equipment, plastic, wood and rubber products, and food and beverage processors.

MANUFACTURING – There are many opportunities for companies to build upon Otsego County's current

base of electronics, plastics, medical manufacturing and healthcare facilities. Entrepreneurs and businesses can capitalize on the cluster of relevant technology companies being launched in the Capital Region, New York City area, and New Jersey.

BUSINESS PARKS – There are three designated industrial parks in Otsego County, including the Pony Farm and River Corp Industrial parks in Oneonta, conveniently located on I-88. The Richfield Business Park is under development in Richfield Springs is on Route 20, and is less than 12 miles from the New York State Thruway.

AGRICULTURE – In recognition of the important role agriculture plays in the economic and cultural life of the residents of Otsego County, the County Agricultural and Farmland Protection Board, with assistance from the County Planning Department, has developed an impressive plan to protect, preserve, and enhance agriculture and family farming.

Bassett Healthcare Network

In the 1920's, Edward Severin Clark, a local philanthropist, built a hospital dedicated to one of central New York's devoted physicians. When completed, he named the hospital in her honor as The Mary Imogene Bassett Hospital. That single hospital has evolved to become a sophisticated health care system committed to meeting the needs of individuals and families in Otsego County and the seven other neighboring counties that comprise the network's service region.

Bassett Healthcare Network is an innovative and unique health care system that connects comprehensive care and services to people living throughout central New York. The network includes five corporately affiliated hospitals, 20 health centers, 20 school-based health centers and a variety of health partners in related fields. Bassett has been ranked as one of the top 100 most integrated health systems in the nation.

Bassett Medical Center

The hub of the network is Bassett Medical Center in Cooperstown, which, in addition to traditional hospital-based care such as maternity, surgical and medical care, also offers sophisticated services not traditionally found in a rural setting. Some of these services include advanced cancer care and heart care, advanced joint and spine care, and a highly-rated birthing center. Bassett Medical Center is also the area's only trauma center and designated stroke center.

Bassett affiliated hospitals A.O. Fox Hospital in Oneonta, O'Connor Hospital in Delhi, Cobleskill Regional Hospital and Little Falls Hospital provide acute inpatient care and 24/7 emergency care.

The specialty care in Cooperstown and the surrounding region, in combination with the network's community-based health centers, results in more than 700,000 outpatient visits per year. Bassett is the region's largest employer with over 4,000 employees on the payroll and has an operating budget of \$550 million. A substantial portion of the budget is devoted to wages and benefits, much of which is spent locally with significant positive impact on the area's economy.

As a teaching hospital and medical school campus affiliated with Columbia University's College of Physicians and Surgeons, and through a nationally renowned Research Institute, Bassett is continually advancing its missions of patient care, teaching and research, always anticipating and developing to meet the needs of the patients it serves across eight counties in central New York.

Oneonta celebrated the laying of the cornerstone for a 22-bed hospital on October 5, 1900. Colonel Reuben Fox, a prominent local politician and businessman, having recognized the need for a community hospital offered \$10,000 as a memorial to his wife, Aurelia Osborn Fox, if the city would provide a suitable site for the building. A.O. Fox is a major economic asset for the region.

A.O. Fox Memorial Hospital is a full service community hospital with an outpatient facility (FoxCare Center) that is unique, innovative and well-liked by patients and has been a showcase for the institution since its creation in 1997. The FoxCare Center blends together a number of outpatient services that include numerous doctors' offices, a health and fitness club, a retail pharmacy, lab and x-ray facilities, a café, a dental practice, a cancer center, rehabilitation services and community education facilities.

On January 1, 2010, A.O. Fox Memorial Hospital became part of the Bassett Healthcare Network.

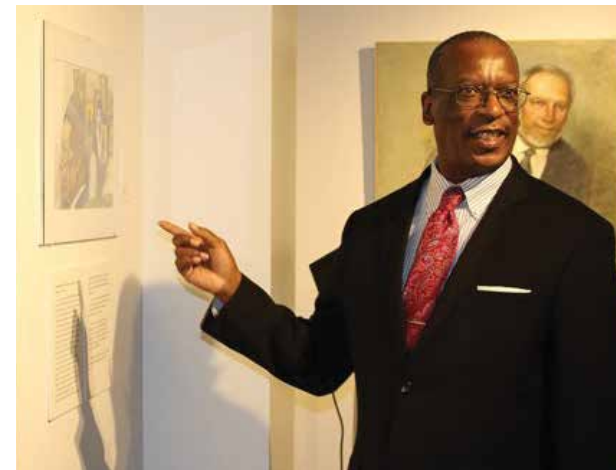

More reasons to choose Hartwick:

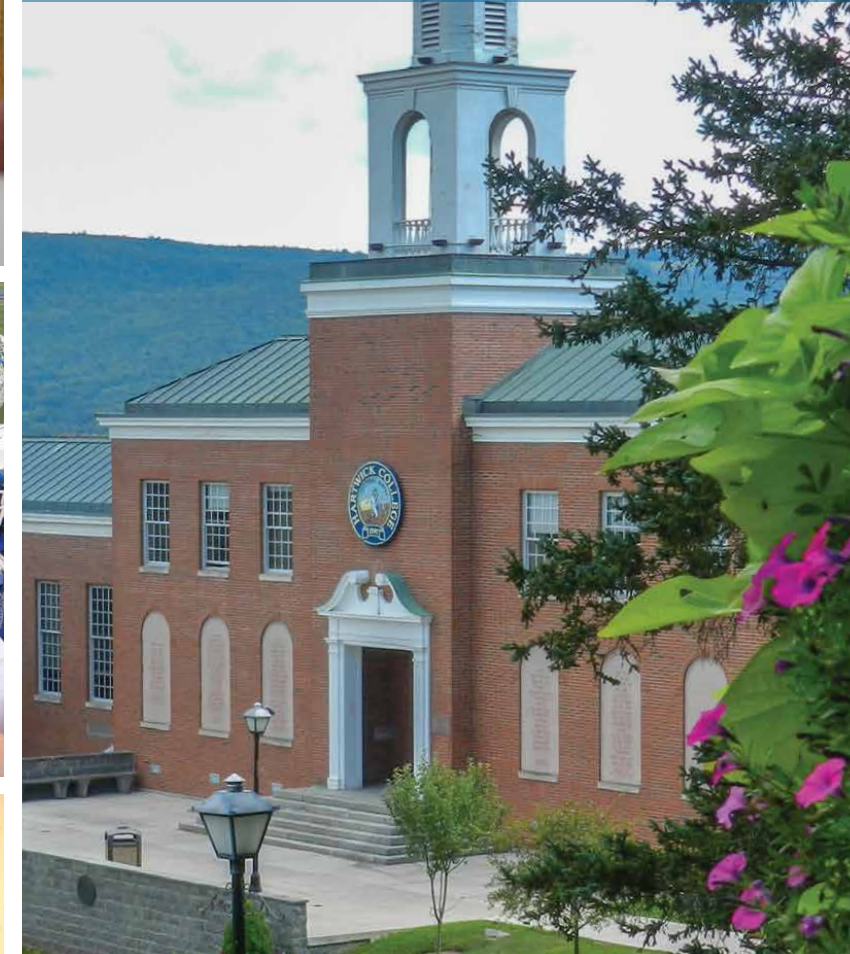

HANDS-ON LEARNING – Hartwick College’s Center for Craft Food & Beverage (CCFB), New York state’s first and only brewing industry resource for testing, education, and business development, supports small and mid-sized breweries, malthouses, farms and other craft food and beverage producers.

Services provided by the Hartwick College CCFB include quality testing for beer and brewing raw materials, technical support, and training.

The center provides Hartwick students with experiential learning opportunities, including internships for current students who are interested in gaining hands on experience in the development, analysis, and testing of food and beverages.

The Hartwick College CCFB is partially funded by a grant from the Appalachian Regional Commission. The College was also awarded an incentive from Empire State Development Corporation through New York State’s Consolidated Funding application process.

- **Athletics.** 32% of Hartwick students play varsity sports.
- **January Term.** J Term at Hartwick is a unique, one-month intensive, faculty-led mini-term where students can travel or explore their unique areas of interest on campus.
- **Peace Corps.** Hartwick College is the only college in New York State that offers a Peace Corps Preparatory Program and one of only a few dozen programs nationwide.
- **Generous scholarships plus financial aid.** In 2018, Hartwick students received over \$30 million in institutional scholarships and grants and over \$60 million in financial aid.

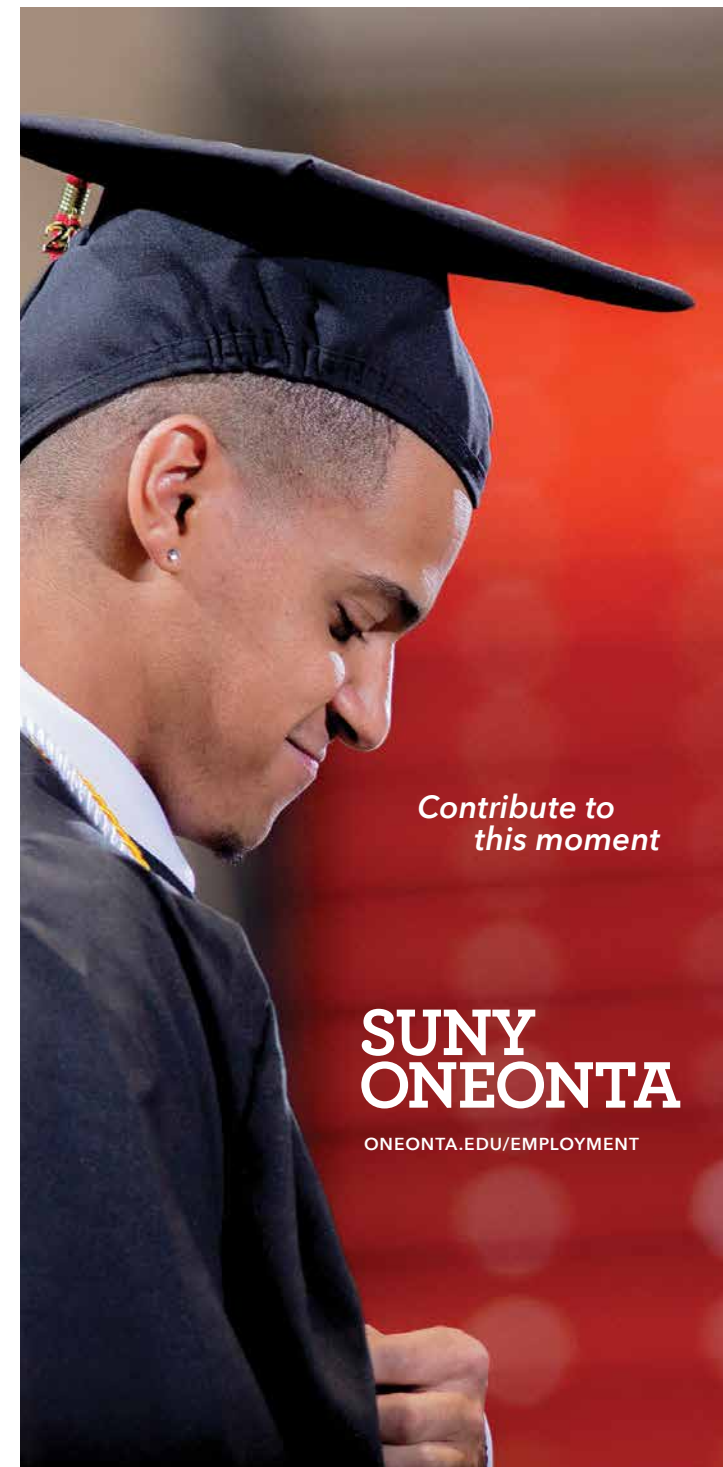

HANDS-ON LEARNING – SUNY Oneonta's A.J. Read Science Discovery Center is a free, hands-on museum for people of all ages and abilities. Its mission is to connect visitors to the joy and power of the scientific process through authentic, interactive exhibits, and to serve as an indispensable Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Math (STEAM) resource for the SUNY Oneonta community and the wider region. Since 1990, it has helped people across the area connect with science through self-discovery and play.

Located in the newly renovated Physical Science Building, the Science Discovery Center hosts thousands of local children each year during field trips and seeks to instill in visitors a lifelong love of science and inspire young people to consider careers in the STEAM fields. Special events include science story hours, weekend workshops, and shows at the college's digital planetarium.

The Center provides SUNY Oneonta students with opportunities to engage in public STEAM outreach as student workers, interns and volunteers, through which they can develop effective science communication skills. Students and faculty often run demonstrations and design new interactive exhibits.

More reasons to choose SUNY Oneonta:

- **Academics.** Education, psychology, business economics, biology and criminal justice are SUNY Oneonta's most popular majors. Newer programs include sport management, exercise science, art and design, international development studies, and environmental sustainability.
- **Opportunity.** Hands-on learning is a key part of the SUNY Oneonta experience. With faculty-led field courses, exchange programs and access to more than 1,000 study abroad programs, students can learn while traveling the world. Closer to home, students can gain real-world experience through internships, job shadowing, service-learning volunteer opportunities, research and creative collaborations with faculty, and leadership programs.
- **Personal attention.** SUNY Oneonta tends to attract students and teachers who are seeking small classes, undergraduate research opportunities, and plenty of student-faculty interaction. Our average class size is 24 and student-faculty ratio is 17 to 1.

- **Co-curricular experiences.** At SUNY Oneonta, there are hundreds of ways to be involved, get connected, and make memories and friends that will last a lifetime. We offer more than 100 clubs that are academic, athletic, cultural, spiritual, humanitarian or interest-based. The college also has 21 Division III athletics teams, dozens of intramural sports, 20 recognized fraternities and sororities, 27 honor societies, hall government opportunities, and a Center for Social Responsibility and Community (CSRC) that coordinates volunteer and service-learning opportunities in the region and beyond.

- **Generous scholarships plus financial aid.** SUNY Oneonta awards approximately \$7.5 million in institutional scholarships each academic year. More than 300 scholarship opportunities are available and, in many cases, scholarships are designated for students majoring in particular fields of study. Tourism In OTSEGO COUNTY

Each year about half a million visitors flock to the world famous village of Cooperstown, home of the National Baseball Hall of Fame, and one of America's best known early writers, James Fenimore Cooper. A walk about the village of Cooperstown brings you past lovely Victorian homes, gardens, village shops, and a great deal of history.

The National Baseball Hall of Fame and Museum is every fan's "Field of Dreams," with three memory-filled floors paying tribute to the game of baseball. The Hall of Fame is open daily year round with the exception of Thanksgiving, Christmas, and New Year's Day.

The Fenimore Art Museum, operated by the New York State Historical Association, presents changing and permanent exhibitions of American Folk Art, North

American Indian art and artifacts, Hudson River School and 19th-century genre paintings, and American photography.

The Farmers' Museum, overlooking Otsego Lake, recreates rural life from the 19th century through exhibits and interactive workshops and offers two dozen authentic, historic buildings on the grounds, including a tavern, farmstead, printing office, pharmacy, blacksmith's shop, doctor's office, and general store. The Farmers' Museum is home to the Empire State Carousel, a hand-crafted merry go-round which celebrates New York State's history, culture and environment.

The Historic Damaschke Field of Oneonta, NY opened its gates in 1906 and is still going strong as one of the oldest active ballparks in America. It was originally named Elm Park until 1968, when the City of Oneonta decided to rename it in honor of Earnest C. "Dutch" Damaschke, a longtime Commissioner of Recreation for Oneonta. During the first two decades of existence, Damaschke hosted a variety of teams ranging from amateur and college all the way to semi-pro and minor league professional baseball. This included a game involving the Sultan of Swat himself, Babe Ruth. His All-Star team played an exhibition game against an Endicott-Johnson team on October 16, 1920. The legend goes as following, "Babe Ruth hit a home run over the right field fence during the eighth inning of the barnstorming game. In the fifth inning of that game, Ruth reportedly fractured a small bone in his left wrist while attempting slide into first base, although the following day in Jersey City he hit another of his exhibition home runs, suggesting that his wrist was fine." Legendary Baseball – Cooperstown is the home of Abner Doubleday Field, the first baseball diamond in the United States (1839). Players of all ages travel from across America and from many foreign countries to play day games on Doubleday Field. The park is a baseball tournament facility with weekly tournaments involving 96 teams. Players spend a week at Cooperstown Dreams Park learning, practicing, and playing baseball. It is the opportunity of a lifetime, and a must-experience for any child who loves baseball! Cooperstown All Star Village is a world-class family baseball resort located just outside the birthplace of baseball, Cooperstown, New York. Their baseball summer camp offers tournaments on major league-style baseball fields for kids. Your team will play teams from across the country and the world!

The Great OUTDOORS

Otsego County residents live in one of the most picturesque regions in all of New York State. If you are a hiker, skier, fisherman, bike rider, equestrian, bird watcher, or someone who simply loves nature and scenic beauty, you'll be delighted with all of the wonderful recreational opportunities awaiting you here.

PARKS, CAMPGROUNDS & WATER ATTRACTIONS –

Otsego County owns and manages 3,600 acres of county forests and parks. These lands are managed for forest products, preservation of wildlife, camping, picnicking, hiking, and other activities. There are 16 county-owned sites. In addition, the county maintains several forests which contain more than 40 miles of woodland roads, providing venues for hiking, snowmobiling, cross-country skiing, horseback riding, and paths for ATVs.

STATE PARKS – There are more than a dozen private campgrounds in the county, in addition to these four outstanding state parks:

Gilbert Lake State Park is one of the largest state parks in central New York. Camping facilities include cabins, electrical hookups, and primitive campsites.

Glimmerglass State Park, located on beautiful Otsego Lake in northern Otsego County, has nearly 600 acres of land developed for picnicking, camping, and hiking.

The Wilbur and Betty Davis State Park in Westford is just a short drive from Cooperstown and features an extensive network of hiking trails and a woodland stream.

Robert V. Riddell State Park offers more than 1,000 acres of forested woodlands in the Susquehanna River Valley near I-88.

WATER ATTRACTIONS – Otsego, Goodyear, Canadarago, and other smaller lakes comprise over 6,800 acres of water surface available for outdoor activities. One can sail, ski, motor, or fish on nearly every lake. The lakes support traditional game and panfish, landlocked salmon, bass, and more. The General Clinton Canoe Regatta is the nation's best flatwater canoe race and attracts a highly appreciative national and international audience.

Arts & CULTURE

Arts, culture, and entertainment are close at hand throughout the County. Plus, our residents have access to all of the arts and cultural programs offered to the students at Hartwick College and SUNY Oneonta.

The Foothills Performing Arts and Civic Center - Located in downtown Oneonta, this state-of-the-art performing arts and cultural center provides South Central New York with top performing arts, modern educational and conference facilities, and a home for many of the area's existing arts groups and artists.

The Glimmerglass Festival - This festival, an annual summer season of operas at the Alice Busch Opera Theater on Otsego Lake, eight miles north of Cooperstown, is the second-largest summer opera festival in the United States.

The Cooperstown Chamber Music Festival - This festival offers an opportunity to hear internationally renowned artists performing a rich and innovative repertoire of masterworks, lesser known treasures, and contemporary compositions.

The Catskill Symphony Orchestra - The Catskill Symphony Orchestra has served the region for almost 50 years, providing 5 live performances to an audience of over 3,500 patrons each season.

The Catskill Choral Society - This Oneonta-based chorus of more than eighty men and women draws



members from surrounding communities and provides workshops, apprenticeships, competitions, chamber singers, and more.

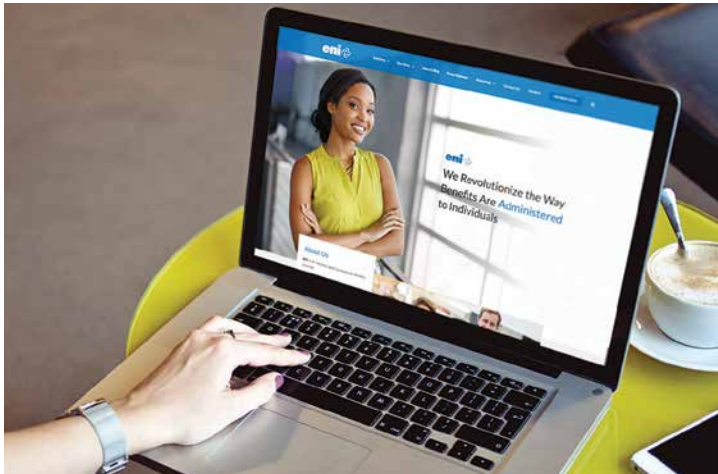
